Step 1: Set a Loss Limit

The first thing you want to do before you even play the pick 5 game is to set a “loss limit”. A loss limit is the spending limit you want to set before even playing the pick 5 game. Setting a loss limit is very important because it will prevent you from losing too much money.

One of the biggest problems many people have playing the lottery is that they end up losing more money than they can afford. That could be for a lot of reasons. The reasons include spending money over and over again. It could also be because some people don't consciously know when they should stop. It can happen because people are drawn and tempted into playing that next game.

If you don't spend a loss limit, you may end up losing more money than you can afford to lose!

But one of the main reasons people lose so much money in the pick 5 lottery is because they spend more money than they can afford to play. This happens because people get emotional and excited about winning and thus they spend so much money.

Now, there is nothing wrong with playing the lottery but there is something wrong with playing more than you can afford to play. And too many pick 5 lottery players play more than they can afford to play. It's easy to overspend because of the emotions and excitement of playing takes over.

So I found out one simple technique to prevent yourself from overspending whenever you play the pick 5 lottery game. In fact, this technique can save you hundreds or even thousands of dollars in the long run because you will prevent yourself from spending too much money like you did in the past.

**If you set a loss limit, you will always play the pick 5 lottery successfully!
Remember, a loss limit should be according to your own personal budget.**

This technique is what I call setting a "loss limit". Basically, you want to put a spending limit on yourself before you even play the pick 5 lottery. That means you want to set a maximum amount of money you are willing to play (and no more) and play only up to that amount every time you play the pick 5 lottery.

Remember, you need to set a loss limit and stick to it. Once you set your personal daily loss limit, you want to stick to that limit. Even though the jackpot may be higher or you may feel luckier, you still want to follow the loss limit. In essence, you want to follow the loss limit every single time because this will help you play responsibly and thus successfully in the long run.

If you cannot afford to spend too much, don't spend too much money in the lottery because most of your plays will be losers according to the realistic odds. SO make sure to set your own daily loss limit and always stick to it.

Step 1 Review:

- ✓ Before you play the pick 5 lottery, make sure to set your daily loss limit.
- ✓ A loss limit is the spending limit you want to put on yourself to insure that you won't play beyond your budget.
- ✓ Never ever play more than your loss limit.
- ✓ Make sure to set your loss limit based on your own financial budget and stick to it.
- ✓ The amount of money you are willing and can afford to lose should be your loss limit.
- ✓ A loss limit will prevent you from losing too much money that you cannot afford to lose.

Step 2: Do Not Play the “Foolish Combos”

Pick 5 research has shown that certain combinations are definitely unlikely to hit. These combinations that do not come up in the pick 5 winning drawings are what I call “Foolish Combos”.

These “foolish combos” are popular in terms of a lot of people playing these numbers. However, the foolish combos rarely come up in the actual winning pick 5 drawings.

The foolish combos include:

- Numbers won before (occurs very infrequently)
- Consecutive numbers (occurs very infrequently)
- From same number groups (occurs very infrequently)
- Pattern styles (lines up OR down) (occurs very infrequently)
- Multiples (3-9-12-15-21) (occurs very infrequently)
- Same last digits (occurs very infrequently)
- Calendar numbers only (limited) (occurs very infrequently)
- Quick pick winners (occurs very infrequently)

Numbers won before:

- Do not choose the exact winning pick 5 combinations from the past because it will be very unlikely that the exact combination from the past will repeat itself in the future.

Consecutive Numbers (ex: 23-24-25-26-27):

- Consecutive combos are combinations such as 1-2-3-4-5 and 15-16-17-18-19. Most people love to play consecutive combos because it just seems easy to pick the numbers without thinking. But the truth is that consecutive combos do not appear often.
- That is why you should NEVER play consecutive combos.

From same number groups (ex: 10-11-13-17-19):

- Number groups are numbers such as:
 - 1-9
 - 10-19
 - 20-29
 - 30-39

- Pick 5 research has shown that it is very rare to have a winning pick 5 combination with all the numbers from the 1 to 9.
- That is why you want to mix up your numbers from different number groups.
- Ideally, you want to have a 2-1-1-1 combination where:
 - 2 numbers are from one number group and 3 numbers are each from one unique group.
 - 2-1-1-1 combinations are the most common type of pick 5 numbers that appear in the winning results.

Pattern styles (lines up OR down)

- Many people like to pick the numbers based on straight lines or diagonal lines on the pick 5 sheet.
- This is not a very effective way to pick your numbers because research has shown those numbers in lines or diagonal patterns do not show up on a frequent basis.

Multiples (ex: 3-9-12-15-21):

- People have their own favorite numbers and many times, they like to pick numbers in multiples of their favorite numbers.

-
- For example, some people like to choose numbers by multiples of 3 such as 3-6-9-12-15-18.
 - So make sure you do not make all your numbers in multiples.

Same last digits (ex: 1-11-21-31-41):

- Some people also like to play numbers where the last digit is the same for each of the numbers in a combination.
- For examples, people like to play numbers like 1-11-21-31-41 where four or five numbers have the same last digit at the end.
- This is popular way to play but studies have shown rarely do real pick 5 winners have numbers with the same last digits at the end.
- So make sure to play numbers where the last digits are not all the same.

Calendar numbers only (ex: 1-13-15-23-30)

- Many people like to play calendar numbers (from 1 to 31) because of their own birthdays as well as their family and friends' birthdays.
- But playing only calendar numbers is actually limiting because you forget to include the numbers beyond the calendar numbers (beyond 31).

- Numbers such as 32 and 33 may have great chances of winning and you may miss out on those numbers if you just focus on the calendar numbers.
- That is why it is important to not only be focused on the calendar numbers.

Quick picks

- Almost 80% of people who play the pick 4 in my store play quick picks. Quick picks are numbers that are generated by the lottery retailer's computer.
- These numbers are the most popular way to play and it is probably the WORST way to play because there is no system behind picking those numbers.
- Quick picks do not take into consideration of the previous winners and thus is an ineffective way to play.
- That is why you should NEVER play quick picks from now on. Instead, do some research and start selecting your numbers based on your research.

Step 2 Review:

- ✓ The foolish combos are combos that are the lottery combinations that are most popular to play by average lottery players.

- ✓ Although foolish combos are popular numbers to play, they rarely (sometimes never) come out in the actual pick 5 drawings.
- ✓ You should never play the “foolish combos” because they are almost guaranteed to be instant losers.
- ✓ The foolish combos include numbers won before, consecutive numbers, same number groups, pattern styles, multiples, same last digits, calendar numbers, and quick picks.
- ✓ Do not play the foolish combos because they have very bad odds of winning.
- ✓ By avoiding the foolish combos, you will instantly and greatly improve your odds of picking the right pick 5 numbers because you are eliminating choices that will most likely not come up.

Step 3: Do Your Research

You have to know that research is a necessary prerequisite in order to find out which numbers to pick that will most likely hit in the future drawings. That is why the next step is to do your research.

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You can get all the crucial information by going to your state (or country's) lottery website because they will show you all the data for the previous winning numbers.

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The best way to do your research is to look at the previous winners for the past 30 drawings. 30 days is a great number because it will show you the most accurate and relevant information for the very next drawings that you want to play.

So all you have to do is to go to your state (or country's) lottery website and record the frequency of all the numbers that appeared in the past 30 drawings.

To do your research using the frequency graph, all you have to do is make a checkmark using the "frequency graph" for the past 30 drawings. Make sure to put a checkmark next to the specific number every time that number appeared in the past 30 drawings.

In the frequency graph, you want to record how many times each of the numbers (1 to 39 or 1 to whatever your pick 5 range is) appeared in the past 30 drawings. This will give you all the necessary information to pick the right winning numbers in the future.

Let me show you an example from my example (in California where I reside).





Frequency Chart





As you can see, there will be certain numbers that appear more frequently than other numbers. The numbers that appear very frequently are called the "hot numbers". The numbers that do not appear very frequently are called "cold numbers".

Step 3 Review:

- ✓ You want to record the past 30 drawings because it will give you the most relevant and accurate data for the future drawings.
- ✓ The best way to research is to go to your state (or country's) lottery website.

- ✓ From there, you want to record the frequency of each of the winning numbers from the past 30 drawings.
- ✓ Use the frequency chart to record the past 30 drawings.
- ✓ Even though it may seem to take a lot of time, you will get much faster at this as you do this more often.
- ✓ Do not ever skip this step because recording the previous winners is an essential step to know what numbers to pick to win in the pick 5 lottery.
- ✓ Make sure to update your pick 5 frequency chart every 15 drawings.

Step 4: Know the 6 Golden Rules

Before you select your pick 5 lottery numbers, you need to know the 6 golden rules for the pick 5 lottery.

The 6 Golden Rules are:

1. Frequency Rule
2. Law of Averages Rule
3. Odds/Even Rule
4. Number Group Rule
5. High/Low Rule
6. Winning Range Rule

Frequency Rule:

In the lottery, there are three types of numbers. The first type is called "hot numbers". The hot numbers are the numbers that have been the most frequent in the previous drawings. The second type of numbers is called the "cold numbers". The cold numbers are numbers that have been the least frequent numbers in the previous drawings. The third type of numbers is "mild numbers". Mild numbers are neither too frequent nor too rare. It is right in the middle.

Many lottery experts have found out that the “hot numbers” have the best chances to hit in the future drawings compared to other type of numbers. Contrary to common belief that numbers that have not hit will eventually hit, the frequency rule states that you should lean more towards picking hot numbers to have the greatest chance of winning in the pick 5 lottery.

That is why according to the frequency rule, you want to find out the hottest numbers from the previous 30 drawings. After you record the frequency of all the numbers in the previous 30 drawings, you want to pick the hottest numbers as your pick 5 number selection. The frequency rule has been proven and tested to bring much better results than just randomly picking any numbers.

Law of Averages Rule:

Contrary to the frequency rule, the second most popular rule is called the “law of averages rule”. Although the two theories may not seem to agree with each other, both theories have been proven to work to produce better pick 5 combinations.

The law of averages rule states that the numbers that have not hit in the past will be the numbers that will most likely hit in the future. Simply stated, the law of averages rule states that the cold numbers are the best numbers to choose to pick the winning pick 5 numbers.

Odds/Even Rule

The odds/even rule states that it is best to have a mixture of odds and even numbers in your pick 5 combination. The history of the actual pick 5 winning numbers has shown that the majority of winning pick 5 numbers is almost always mixed evenly with odds and even numbers.

This is according to what I call the "mixed number" theory. A lot of the past winning pick 5 numbers have rarely been all even or all odd numbers. Instead, they come out to be mixed with a close to even amount of odd and even numbers.

Basically the "mixed number theory states that all lotto numbers will be close to evenly mixed with different styles of numbers. The "mixed number" theory works for other lottery rules as well which I will show you in the next sections.

For example, the majority of pick 5 winning numbers have:

- ✓ **2 odd numbers + 3 even numbers**
- ✓ **2 even numbers + 3 odd numbers**

This also means that you NEVER want to pick your pick 5 combinations to have either all even or all odd numbers. Sometimes there will be pick 5 combinations where there is 1 even number & 4 odd numbers or 1 odd number and 4 even numbers. However, this 1/4 or 4/1 combination is only minority of the time.

The majority of the time the pick 5 combinations will be 2/3 combination. So that is why you want to make sure you have a mixture of even and odd numbers in your pick 5 numbers.

Number Group Rule:

The "number group rule" states that the winning pick 5 numbers will be evenly divided amongst each number groups. For the pick 5 lottery, the number groups are divided into several different number groups. This is also according to the mixed number" theory which I talked about earlier.

The number groups are:

- ✓ **1 – 9**
- ✓ **10 – 19**
- ✓ **20 – 29**
- ✓ **30 – 39**
- ✓ **40 – 49**
- ✓ **More if applicable**

For the state I live in (California), there are 39 possible numbers for the pick 5 lottery. So there would be 4 total number groups which would be:

- ✓ **1 – 9**

✓ **10 – 19**

✓ **20 – 29**

✓ **30 – 39**

If your state (or country's) pick 5 lottery is bigger or smaller, you will have more or less number groups.

But for my example, let's just say you have 39 possible numbers to choose from in your pick 5 lottery. Then you would have 4 total number groups (1-9/10-19/20-29/30-39).

When you select your pick 5 numbers, make sure to have either 2 odd numbers & 3 even numbers OR 3 even numbers & 2 odd numbers. This will insure you the best possible odds of getting a winning pick 5 combination.

Sometimes, you can choose a number for each number group except one number group. SO you can have a 2-2-1-0 type of format (2 numbers from 1-9, 2 numbers from 10-19, 1 number from 20-29, and 0 numbers from 30-39) and can win as well.

The important part is you cover the majority of the number groups as opposed to not covering them at all.

Low/High Rule:

The low/high rule states that the winning pick 5 numbers will most likely have a mixture of high and low numbers. That means you want to have either 3 low and 2 high numbers or 2 low and 3 high numbers.

If your pick 5 lottery range is 39, you want to divide that in half. So the numbers from 1 to 20 would be your "low numbers" and the numbers from 21 to 39 will be your "high numbers".

Lottery research has shown that the majority of the actual pick 5 winning numbers have a mixture of both high and low numbers. It is very rare to see pick 5 combinations having only low numbers or only high numbers. As you can see, this also follows the "mixed numbers" theory that states there will be a close to evenly matched sets of numbers (low and high numbers in this case).

This also means you never ever want to have pick 5 lottery combinations where you have all high numbers or all low numbers.

A good pick 5 combination would be:

- 2 low numbers + 3 high numbers
- 3 low numbers + 2 high numbers

A bad pick 5 combination would be:

- 5 low numbers
- 5 high numbers

- 1 low number + 4 high numbers
- 1 high number + 4 low numbers

Although the 1 /4 combination appears sometimes (either 1 low number + 4 high numbers OR 4 high numbers + 1 low number), this combination does not occur most of the time. That is why it is essential for you to make your pick 5 combination a 3/2 or 2/3 combination.

So make sure to make your pick 5 combination either 3 low numbers and 2 high numbers or 2 high numbers and 3 low numbers.

Winning Range Rule:

Almost 90% of all winning drawings for the pick 5 is between the "winning range". The winning sum is the sum of all the numbers in a single pick 5 combination.

For example, the winning sum for 4-14-21-30-39 would be 108. You would get 108 because $4 + 14 + 21 + 30 + 39 = 108$.

Interestingly, pick 5 history shows that the majority of pick 5 winning numbers tend to be within a target range (called the "winning range"). In fact, 70% of all winning numbers are within the winning range.

To help you select the right combinations, I have found out the most frequent winning sum total as well as the most frequent winning range for all the pick 5 games.

5/53 means a pick 5 game where you can pick numbers from 1 to 53. 5/39 would mean a pick 5 game where you can pick numbers from 1 to 39. So look at the sum table and take note of the most frequent sum as well as the most frequent sum range.

After that, make sure to pick your pick 5 combinations so that your numbers will be within the most frequent winning range. This will allow you to have the best possible chance of getting a winner in the pick 5 game.

On the other hand, a winning sum of 15 would be very unlikely to hit because the chances of 1-2-3-4-5 hitting would be very low. That is why you should never pick all low numbers or all high numbers.

Instead, make sure your numbers are balanced from low to medium to high so that your winning sum would be in the winning range.

The winning range is the most popular range that shows up the most amount of times in the pick 5 lottery game. The winning range is the sum of the range that comprises up to 90% of all pick 5 lottery winning numbers.

From this information, you always want to make sure that your pick 5 numbers add up to be a number within the winning range. And for the highest probability of winning, you want to pick a pick 5 combination that will be close to the winning sum.

That is why it is important to have your numbers be balanced in order to reach the winning range and winning sum. This will provide you the best possible chance to get a big winner in the pick 5 lottery.

So those are the 6 golden rules explained in detail. Remember, you want to make sure that your pick 6 combinations are created from following the principles explained in the 6 golden rules.

I will show you exactly how to create your pick 5 combinations based on the 6 golden rules in the next steps.

Step 4 Review:

- ✓ The 6 golden rules are the essential rules that have been proven and tested through years of lottery research.

- ✓ The 6 golden rules are:
 - Frequency Rule
 - Law of Averages Rule
 - Odds/Even Rule
 - Number Group Rule
 - Low/High Rule
 - Winning Range Rule

- ✓ You want to make sure your pick 5 combinations always follow the principles of the 6 golden rules.

Step 5: Get Your Top 16 Numbers

After you do your frequency graph, you want to find out your “Top 16 Numbers”. The top 16 numbers will be the 16 numbers that will most likely hit in the future drawings based on the 6 golden rules that I talked about in the previous section.

For review, the 6 golden rules are:

- Frequency Rule
- Law of Averages Rule
- Odds/Even Rule
- Number Group Rule
- High/Low Rule
- Winning Range Rule

To create your pick 5 numbers based on the 6 golden rules, you want to follow my step-by-step instructions on picking your pick 5 combination.

The 5 Steps to Create Your Top 16 Numbers:

- 1) Step 1: Pick the HOT # for each number group
- 2) Step 2: Pick the “mirror number” (for the HOT numbers)

- 3) Step 3: Pick the COLD # for each number group
- 4) Step 4: Pick the "mirror number" (for the COLD numbers)
- 5) Step 5: Select the 2 hot numbers & 2 cold numbers from each number group as your "Top 16" Numbers (Your top numbers will be more or less numbers according to the range of your pick 5 lottery game)

Tie Rule (Rule when the #'s are tied)

You only use the rules when there is a frequency tie amongst two or more numbers.

- 1) The first thing you want to do is to "even out" the process by choosing the opposite of the previous type of number
 - a. If the number for the previous number group was an ODD number, you want to choose an EVEN number for the next number group.
- 2) If you can't do the first step or if there is still is a tie, then you want to look beyond the 30th drawing to find out which number is more HOT or more COLD (depending on choosing a hot or cold number).
 - a. After you do step 1, if there is still a tie for 2 numbers, then you want to look beyond the 30th drawing (31st, 32nd, etc) until you find out which number was more HOTTER (or COLDER) the most recently depending on if you are looking for a hot number or cold number.

If you can't "even out the process" or there still is a tie in the frequency, go beyond the 30th drawing and find out the most relevant number and pick that as your hot (or cold) number for its number group.

Step 1: Pick the HOT # for each number group

The first thing you want to do is to look at the past 30 drawings and find out the hottest number for each number group. So for my example, if there is 39 possible numbers for my pick 5 lottery, you would have 4 numbers groups (1-9, 10-19, 20-29, 30-39).

For each number group, you want to look for the hottest number and record it on a piece of paper.

For example in California, there is 39 possible numbers. So I would look at my data and find out the hottest number for each number group.

It would look like this:

Number Group	Hottest #
1 - 9	9
10 - 19	12,17
20 - 29	23,29
30 - 39	34

Notice there is a tie for the number group 10-19 and the number group 20-29. In this case, you want to do your best to even out the numbers.

By "evening out your numbers", I mean you want to mix your numbers as even/odd or hot/cold or low/high combinations.

Remember, if you find one number that stands out (hot or cold), you want to just select as your number. But if there is a tie, you want to "even out the numbers".

For my example, you can notice that the 1-9 number group had a hot number 9 (which is an odd number) and the next number group happens to have a tie between 12 and 17. Since 9 is an odd number, you want to pick 12 (for the

number group 10-19) because 12 is an even number. You want to even out the process.

Then for the number group 20-29, you can notice that there is a tie for the hot number amongst the number 23 and the number 29. Since the previous number was even, you want to pick an odd number. Naturally, the number group 20-29 has two tied numbers that are odd numbers. In this case, you just want to pick the number which was MORE frequent beyond the 30 drawings.

So you want to go back beyond the 30 drawings and find out which number came out MOST recently. Whatever number that is, you want to choose that as your hot number (for that specific number group).

For the number group 20-29, the number 29 appeared MORE recently than the number 23.	05-26-2008	19 02 13 03 12

For my example, there was a tie between 23 and 29. Here, I would pick 29 as my hot number (for number group 20-29) because it was the MORE frequent number beyond the 30th drawing.

So for the number group 20-29, I looked back beyond the 30th drawing and found out that 29 was more recently hit. So I would make 29 my hottest number for the number group 20-29.

For the number group 30-39, you would pick 34 because there is only 34 that stands out as the hottest number. If the hottest number was an odd number, you would still select it the odd number because it was the hottest number.

You want to “even out the numbers” only when there is a tie amongst 2 or more numbers.

So for my example, the hot numbers would be revised to:

Number Group	Hottest #	Mirror #
1 – 9	9	
10 – 19	12	
20 – 29	29	
30 – 39	34	

Step 2: Pick the “mirror number” (for the HOT numbers)

From here, you want to select the mirror number. The mirror number is the opposite type of number. For instance if you have an odd number, the mirror number would be the even number. For this hot number section, your mirror number would be the hot number with the opposite type (odd/even) of number.

For this example, the 1-9 number group has an hot odd number (9). Thus, the mirror number for this would be a hot even number. As I look in the frequency table, I notice that 4 is the hottest even number. Thus, I would make 4 the mirror for the 1-9 number group.

For the 10-19 number group, I want to look for an odd number since the hottest number for this group is an even number. notice that 17 is the hottest odd number. Thus, 17 would be my mirror number for this group.

For the 20-29 number group, I want to look for the hottest even number since the hottest number (29) is an odd number. There is a tie between 24 and 26 in terms of frequency. So you want to go beyond the 30th drawing and find out which one was hotter (hit more recently). I notice that 24 was hit more recently so I would choose 24 as my hot mirror number for the 20-29 number group.

For the 30-39 number group, I would want to pick a hot odd number because the hottest number was an even number. 31 is the hottest odd number so I would pick 31 as my mirror number for the 30-39 number group.

Number Group	Hottest #	Mirror #
1 – 9	9	4
10 – 19	12	17
20 – 29	29	24
30 – 39	34	31

Step 3: Pick the COLD # for each number group

Now, you want to pick the coldest (least frequent) number from each of the number groups in your pick 5 lottery. Remember, you want to pick only ONE cold number for each number group.

So for my example, you would want to pick:

Number Group	Coldest #
1 – 9	3
10 – 19	11,18,19
20 – 29	22,28
30 – 39	36

As you can notice, the number group 10-19 and 20-29 have 3 and 2 number respectively. You are supposed to pick only 1 cold number but I wrote down the 3 and 2 numbers here because they were tied for the cold number spot.

In case, there is a tie, you want to "even out the numbers". So since the 1-9 number group has an odd number (3), you want to choose an even number for the next section.

That means for the 10-19 number group, you want to pick an even number. So for this example, you would want to pick 18 as your cold number for the 10-19 number group.

Then for the number group 20-29, you would want to select either 22 or 28. In this case, there isn't any odd number you can choose from. So you would want to go beyond the 30th drawing and find out which number was hit least recently.

After I look beyond the 30th drawing, I find out that 28 was hit less recently. That means 28 would be your cold number for the number group 20-29.

For the 30-39 group, there is only 36 stands out as the coldest number. So you would pick 36 as your hottest number for the number group 30-39.

So your cold number group would look like this.

Number Group	Coldest #	Mirror #
1 – 9	3	
10 – 19	18	
20 – 29	28	
30 – 39	36	

Step 4: Pick the “mirror number” (for the COLD numbers)

Now, you want to look for the “mirror number” for each of the numbers in each number group. Remember, the mirror number is the opposite type of number. So if your number is an even number, the mirror number will be an odd number. You want to create a mirror number for each of the numbers to even out the process.

So from my cold numbers, I would look for the mirror numbers. After looking at the data, my mirror numbers will be:

Number Group	Coldest #	Mirror #
1 – 9	3	2
10 – 19	18	11
20 – 29	28	25
30 – 39	36	33

For the 1-9 number group, I want to look for an even number because the coldest # was an odd number. I can see that the coldest even number is 2 for the 1-9 number group. So 2 would be my mirror number.

For the 10-19 number group, I want to look for the coldest odd number. I notice there is a tie amongst 11 and 19. So I would look beyond the 30th drawing and find out that 11 was more cold. So 11 would be my mirror # for the 10-19 number group.

For the 20-29 number group, I would also want to look for an odd number because 28 is an even number. Remember, you are still looking for the cold number but you are looking for the opposite type of number. I find out that 25 is the coldest odd number for this number group. So 25 will be mirror number for the 20-29 number group.

For the 30-39 number group, I want to look for an odd number because 36 (coldest for this number group) is an even number. I notice there is a tie between 33 and 39 for the coldest odd number for this number group. So I look beyond the 30th drawing and find out that 33 is more of a cold number. So 33 will be my mirror number for the 30-39 number group.

Step 5: Select the 2 hot numbers & 2 cold numbers from each number group as your "Top 16" Numbers (Your top numbers will be more or less numbers according to the range of your pick 5 lottery game)

So from the hot & cold numbers, I would get my Top 16 numbers. The top 16 numbers for this example would be:

"Top 8 Hot Numbers"	"Top 8 Cold Numbers"

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Step 5 Review:

- The top 16 numbers are numbers that will most likely hit in the future drawings because they are picked from the principles taught in the 6 golden rules.
- You want to follow my 5 steps to create your "top 16 numbers".
 - Step 1: Pick the HOT # for each number group
 - Step 2: Pick the "mirror number" (for the HOT numbers)
 - Step 3: Pick the COLD # for each number group
 - Step 4: Pick the "mirror number" (for the COLD numbers)
 - Step 5: Select the 2 hot numbers & 2 cold numbers from each number group as your "Top 16" Numbers (Your top numbers will be more or less numbers according to the range of your pick 5 lottery game)
- Rule when the frequency of the #'s are tied
 - Even out the process by choosing the "mirror number"

-
- If you can't do the previous step, then go beyond the 30th drawing and find out the more relevant number (most recently hot or most recently cold).

Step 6: Create your Pick 5 Lottery Combinations

After getting your Top 16 numbers, you are now ready to create your pick 5 combinations. The point of getting your top 16 numbers was to play from a smaller pool of numbers that are most likely to hit in the future drawings based on the top lottery principles (as explained in the 6 golden rules).

So from your top 16 numbers, you are going to create your pick 5 combos using the "pick 5 combo graph".

"Pick 5 Combo Graph:"

Your Pick-5 Combinations	"Top 8 Hot Numbers"								"Top 8 Cold Numbers"								
Combo #1

So for my example, I would write down the top 8 hot numbers and top 8 cold numbers in the pick 5 combo graph. Make sure to line the numbers from numerical order. So your combo graph for this example should look like this.

From here, you want to make as much pick 5 combinations according to your budget. That means to follow your "loss limit". If your daily loss limit is \$10, then you want to ONLY make 10 pick 5 combinations.

When you are making your pick 5 combinations, make sure it is 3/2 or 2/3 in terms of picking 3 hot numbers & 2 cold numbers (or 2 hot numbers & 3 cold numbers).

For illustration purposes let's say I have a loss limit of \$5. Then I would make 5 pick 5 combinations. You want to pick any 3 from the hot section & any 2 from the cold section (or any 2 from the hot section & any 3 from the cold section).

Pick 5 Combo Graph Rules (based on the "mixed numbers" theory)

You want to pick your pick 5 combos using the combo graph. The rules I teach you here are based on the "mixed number" theory. It states that the most likely to hit pick 5 numbers will have a mixture of different styles of numbers. For

instance, there will be a mixture of odd and even numbers (instead of it being all 5 odd numbers or all 5 even numbers).

Just follow these "pick 5 combo graph rules" and you will make sure your numbers will follow the "mixed numbers" theory which will maximize your chances of getting a good winner in the next drawings.

- 1) Pick at least 1 number for each number group.
 - a. 1-2-1-1
 - b. 1-1-2-1
 - c. 1-1-1-2
 - d. 2-1-1-1
 - e. 2-2-1-0 (This format is still recommended if you play a lot of numbers because as long as MOST of the number groups are covered, it is a good format).
- 2) Pick at least 2/3 Odd/Even Combo
 - a. 2 Odd Numbers & 3 Even Numbers
 - b. 3 Odd Numbers & 2 Even Numbers
- 3) Pick a 2/3 Hot/Cold Combo
 - a. 2 Hot Numbers & 3 Cold Numbers
 - b. 3 Hot Numbers & 2 Cold Numbers
- 4) Make the Sum Total to be in your "Winning Range"
 - a. Based on the range of your pick 5 lottery, you want the total sum to be in the "winning range"

Remember, you want to play the same numbers for the next 15 drawings and after the 15th drawing, update your frequency table and change your pick 5 numbers. Using the same pick 5 combinations for 15 drawings will be accurate and relevant but you should change your frequency table (thus change your numbers) after the 15th drawing.

The top 16 numbers are the numbers that are MOST likely to hit based on the many proven and tested lottery principles (explained in the 6 golden rules). The key is that my pick 5 number selection system is based on the principles that have been proven and tested to most likely bring winners for years and years.

That is why when you use my method, it is like you are picking numbers from a MUCH smaller pool instead of playing from a big pool like 99% of other pick 5 lottery players. In fact, 50% of all winning numbers for the next 8 days came from the top 16 numbers.

By systematically slimming down your pool to a group of numbers that will most likely hit (your Top 16 numbers), you are greatly improving your odds of getting a big winner in the pick 5 lottery game.

Remember, the more numbers you play the better chances you get. But remember to never ever go over your loss limit because playing responsibly is the key to long term success in the pick 5 lottery.

Step 6 Review:

- After you get your top 16 numbers, you want to create your pick 5 combos using the “combo graph”.
- You must select your pick 5 combos based on the 6 golden rules
- When you pick your pick 5 combination, you should:

- Pick at least 1 number for each number group (sometimes you can skip 1 number group if you play a lot of numbers).
- Pick at least 2/3 Odd/Even Combo
- Pick a 2/3 Hot/Cold Combo
- Make the Sum Total to be in your "Winning Range"
- Make sure to follow the loss limit. That means to only create pick 5 combinations based on your budget and do not exceed that budget.
- Update your pick 5 frequency table every 15 drawings because that will help you keep your numbers accurate and relevant to the previous drawings.

Step 7: Go Home

The last thing you want to do after you have done all these steps is to go home! That's right. Too many pick 5 lottery players end up going to the store and being tempted to play other lottery games. That is bound to happen because the store is full of posters and advertisements that entice you to spend more money in the lottery.

The store is kind of like a mini-casino because it will eventually tempt even the non gamblers to spend money in the lotto. Now, there is nothing wrong with playing the lottery but there is something wrong with playing the lottery without doing any research.

After you play your pick 5 lottery, go home because it will help you maximize your profits in the end. The longer you stay in the store, the more likely you can end up impulsively buying more lottery tickets without doing the crucial research.

And in order to do effective research, you must go back home and do it before you come out and play your numbers. Otherwise, you will most likely get a lot of losers playing the quick picks or just randomly picking any numbers like 99% of most lottery players do.

It is essential that you do your research every single time before you play the pick 5 lottery or any other lottery game. That is why when you go into the

store, all you want to do is play the games you already pre-selected (based on your research) and then go home! That's it.

Do not stay in the store any longer because you might easily get tempted into spending money on quick picks for other lottery games. And if you do play quick picks, most likely they will be losers anyways.

Don't play the lottery impulsively like so many people do. Playing the lottery impulsively is the biggest reason for people losing a lot of money. So it is much better to play your pick 5 lottery games (based on research) and leave the store immediately.

Step 7 Review:

- After you play the pick 5 lottery, go home!
- Do not spend another second looking at other lottery games because that is the fastest way to lose your money.
- Remember, when you play the lottery impulsively, you will most likely lose.
- You must do your research before playing. That means you have to go back home and do your research before you play the lottery.
- Chances are you have not done the research for other lottery games so do not waste your time inside the store because the more you spend your time there, the more likely you will end up losing money.

- Playing only according to your loss limit and going home will provide you to have maximum profit in the end because you will smartly spend your money only on the games you did your research on.

Conclusion

You are one step ahead of almost 99% of other pick 5 lottery players who do not have any effective strategy to win in the pick 5 game.

And also remember that no lottery system is one hundred percent full proof including my system. Although my system is based on years of research and proven and tested theories, it is not 100% full proof. So make sure to play the pick 5 lottery responsibly for best results in the long run.

Like any other gambling game, it can lead to losing money. That is why it is essential that you set a loss limit from the beginning and always stick to it. Thus, you will insure yourself to play the pick 5 lottery responsibly and successfully in the long run.
